SECOND CHANCE: Animal group gets \$7.5K

For the fifth consecutive year, Second Chance Fund for Animal Welfare, a local nonprofit provider of cat spay/neuter services, has received funding from the Massachusetts Animal Coalition. The 2009 grant of \$7,500 was raised through the “I’m Animal Friendly” license plate program sold through the Registry of Motor Vehicles. Since the program’s inception, Second Chance has received nearly \$47,000.

“SCFAW is honored to be recognized as one of only 30 Massachusetts animal organizations to receive a MAC license plate grant,” said Jan Beckwith, Bolton resident and president of Second Chance. “We share with our colleagues the common goal of reducing the number of unwanted, frequently homeless, animal births in the state. The MAC grant will help us accomplish this important goal.”
