We all know why we spay - or fix - our female pet cats: to avoid unwanted kittens. Male cats, too, benefit greatly from being fixed - or neutered.

Unneutered male cats are prone to spray urine to mark their territory, which neutering can greatly reduce.

Unfixed males are often more aggressive toward their human companions and other unneutered cats.

He's also more likely to wander in search of female cats, increasing the chance he'll be lost or hit by cars.

And neutering virtually eliminates the possibility of tumors and cancers of his reproductive organs.
